Group Certification - *(To attend, clients must complete all prior steps discussed in Orientation and Intake.)* Group Certification is only hosted on Thursday of EVERY OTHER WEEK. Group Certification starts at 10:00 a.m. and sign up begins at 9:00 a.m. Starts at 1:00pm- and sign up begins at 12:00pm Attendance is required for individuals interested in WIOA funding for training. Children are not permitted in Group Certification or in person Workshops.

On-Line WIOA Orientation

Topics include overview of the Virginia Career Works Hampton Center, step-by-step procedures of the Career Resource Center; registration criteria; general program considerations; customer responsibilities; training providers self-assessments and the process for applying for WIOA services.

DARS (Department of Aging and Rehabilitation)

Provides information on employment services for person with disabilities which include accommodation, work, assessments, and referrals.

Virginia Department of Social Services – Come and find out information on a broad range of services and programs that empower residents to maintain safe, healthy, and independent lives as well as assistance through difficulties and emergency situations. These include, but are not limited to:

Financial Assistance/Benefit Programs – Information for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance (SNAP), Medicaid, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), Energy Assistance and Emergency Assistance.

Family, Children and Adult Services – Child Welfare Services, Childcare Assistance, Child Protective Services, Foster Care, Adoption, Services for Senior and Disabled Adults, and Adult Protective Services.

Prevention Services – Home Visiting Programs, Youth Services, Parenting Programs, Employment Services, Virginia Initiative for Education and Work (VIEW), SNAP Employment and Training (SNAPET).

Services for the Homeless – Housing assistance, case management services, employment assistance, personal hygiene facilities and referrals to available assistance in the Community.

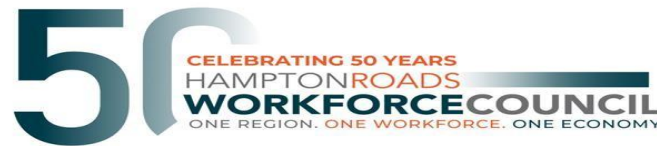
