Employment Workshop Descriptions

On-Line WIOA Orientations 101:

Prevention Services – Home Visiting Programs, Youth Services, Parenting Programs, Employment Services, Virginia Initiative for Education and Work (VIEW), SNAP Employment and Training (SNAPET).

Services for the Homeless – Housing assistance, case management services, employment assistance, personal hygiene facilities and referrals to available assistance in the Community.
